Team Breckenridge Sports Club Is On Course!

Team Breckenridge Sports Club (formerly Quantum Sports Club) is on course for another record season. Team Breckenridge Sports Club (TBK) is a Breckenridge based ski team for Alpine, freeride and mogul athletes of ages 5 to 60. They train and compete around Colorado, nationally and even internationally. The success of Team Breck comes from the depth and experience of its coaching staff, which is among the best in the industry. Team Breckenridge was founded in 1989 by John Leffler and John Dowling, who headed up the Alpine and Freestyle Programs respectively.

On the **Alpine side of Team Breckenridge Coaches John Leffler, Olin Armstrong and Jeff Westcott** have helped produce over 50 members of the US Ski Team, US Olympic Team, US World Champion Team, US National Junior and Senior Champions, Junior Olympians and NCAA All Americans. **Team Breckenridge Sports Club has been recognized as one of the top ten junior racing teams in the country by the leading industry newspaper, Ski Racing.** Leffler and Armstrong have produced dozens of local athletes who have reached the highest level, including Jake Fiala who competed for the US in the 2002 Salt Lake City Olympics. Armstrong, who joined Team Breck in 1991 after coaching the USST Europa Cup Team. Jeff Westcott is well known in the Summit County community through his Maverick Sports Promotions; his Mountain Bike Little League Program has introduced most Summit County kids to the sport of mountain biking, and he brings this same enthusiasm and passion to skiing!

Chris Hawks heads up the Hawk's Freeride Program at Team Breckenridge, and he has lived in Breckenridge for over 16 years competing and coaching. Hawks has competed in three **X Games**, and **won the Gold Medal in the 1999 X Games**. Hawks is considered a Pioneer of the current Freeride movement. Since retiring from competition, aside from coaching at Team Breck, he has judged almost every high level freeride contest including the X games and Dew tour.

The Mogul Team is headed up by John Dowling, who after starting Team Breck back in 1989, then coached for the Canadian World Cup Ski Team, before returning to Summit County. Dowling has coached over 20 athletes onto the US Ski Team and other World Cup Mogul Teams, including Olympians Evan Dybvig, Alex Wilson, Tami Bradley, Jeremy Bloom, and Toby Dawson. His world famous May Camps held right at our local Arapahoe Basin Ski Area include coaching from current US Ski Team members such as Pat Deneen (who just won the Olympic Trials in Steamboat last week!), Joe Discoe, Heather McPhie and David Babic.

Team Breck is on course with its current athletes who are competing in the US Nationals and Junior Olympics as well as the Slopestyle and Extreme Big Mountain Competitions. The Alpine Elite athletes are looking forward to racing in the International Competitions in Europe this February.

Freeride is looking for successful Slopestyle and Big Mountain competitions this year from the dual team of Cody's: Cody Potter and Cody Cirillo, along with Mark Nowakiwsky, Cullan Moran, Paul McSparin, Lance Lipuma and female stars Leila Spilman and Katie Turner. The depth of the Freeride Team means many years of success, as there are almost 40 athletes participating in this program!

Top mogul competitors include Dylan Walczyk, a three-time member of the Junior Olympic Team and Gold Medalist in his age group at the 2008 Junior Olympics, Bruce Perry who is ranked third in the USA 13 and under category and was a two-time medalist at the 2008 and 2009 Junior Olympics, and other Junior Olympians Alisha Sheifley, Kaitlin Harrell and Sarah Johnson. Up and coming young skiers new to Rocky Mountain Division competitions this year include Alex Debonville, Bryce Sawhney, Gabe Johnson, and Lindsey Eckhoff. The Mogul Team looks forward to hosting Singles and Dual Moguls Competitions on the famed Mach 1 at Breckenridge Ski Area on January 30-31, 2010; these events are open to the public and lots of fun to watch!

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
