- Ticket Office: 7:45am Each Day. Located at the bottom of the Quicksilver Chairlift. Racer Tickets - \$27/day (12 years and younger). One, Two or Three day tickets are available.  
Family Tickets - \$40 AND MUST HAVE A SPECTATOR VOUCHER
- Lifts: Open at 8:15am Friday; 8:00am on Saturday and Sunday, Quicksilver (6-PAK) Superchair to the Falcon Superchair. (No lift line cutting!)
- Trail: Cimarron, Peak 10. Access using the Quicksilver (6-PAK) then the Falcon Lift.

- Running order: J4 girls-J4 boys; 2<sup>nd</sup> run Saturday will reverse the order from 1<sup>st</sup> run. 3<sup>rd</sup> race run will TRS the original order. **KEEP same bibs for all runs all days. 45 second Intervals**
- Flags: Flag Zones at “160” and “Trinity”
- DSQ List: Disqualifications will be posted at the scoreboard immediately following each run.
- Awards: Saturday, 30 minutes after the race by the Beaver Run Parking lot  
 Sunday, 30 minutes after the race by the Beaver Run Parking lot
- Training Requirement: Athletes must participate in a Training Run prior to competing in a Race. The only scheduled training is Friday. Athletes that cannot attend Friday MAY have an opportunity to train on a limited basis Saturday for Sunday's race.
